OUTLINE

Suzanne will demonstrate and discuss float loading techniques.

Suzanne's students will also show how to float load their horses willingly and safely without the owner needing to step on the float before the horse.

Then test how willing they are to stay in the float with tail gate still on the ground.

Morning session Demonstration will include:

- Preparation required prior to asking your horse to go on the float.
- What to do if your horse does not want to go on the float.
- When is the appropriate time to do up the tail gate.
- Unloading horses safely.
- Safety Tips

Afternoon session - Workshop

- discover for yourself with your own horse the ingredients needed to float load your horse consistently and safely.
- Suzanne will be available for follow up support.
